Criteria

This participation-based badge is awarded to participants who have completed the three-hour live and interactive online training, *Online Training Skills (Advanced)*. Upon completion of the training, participants are able to:

- State the primary online training tools and platforms for the delivery of online training;
- Determine the relative advantages and disadvantages of online communication and training platforms;
- State the major platforms for collaborative document sharing and group work;
- Explain what needs to be considered to determine the appropriate design of training sessions;
- Describe how the appropriate blend of training methods, content and style contributes to the overall effectiveness of an online training course;
- State the major challenges for the trainer/facilitator in delivering online sessions, and identify productive responses to these challenges.

This badge is issued to learners for participating in an interactive online training followed by a brief reflection. Participants must satisfactorily answer two questions on what they learnt from the training and how they are applying their learning. There is no formal assessment. The estimated learning time is three hours.
